He is well know for his museum quality collection of prehistoric shark teeth and fossils found diving the rivers of South Carolina and is equally know as a Treasure Hunter. He metal detects while combing local beaches, parks, farms and anywhere else that is permissible. Mike has been featured on the front cover of *Newsday*, within Captain Dan Berg's *Wreck Valley* and *Long Island Shore Diver* books, as well as in many prominent treasure hunting magazines. Last count he had recovered well over 700 gold rings and now weighs his silver by the pound. His knowledge of coins, buttons and other artifacts is legendary and he is considered among the best shallow water hunters in the North East.
